

Covid rapid response centre inaugurated at Delhi's Rajiv Gandhi Hospital

NEW DELHI, AUG 25 --/ A COVID-19 rapid response centre was inaugurated on Wednesday at a leading Delhi government-run coronavirus facility, bolstering the city's healthcare infrastructure ahead of a possible third wave of the viral disease.

The centre, which includes an ICU unit, will act as a buffer zone between the patient arrival area and the medical wards. It was opened by Delhi Health Minister Satyendar Jain at the

Rajiv Gandhi Super Speciality Hospital. Authorities at the 650-bed hospital, which played a critical role in providing Covid care during the first two waves of the pandemic, said, "We need to be prepared for a similar surge (in the future)." For better management of patients and for matching of bed turnover to the number of patients arriving in real-time, rapid response centre is the need of the hour, a senior official of the hospital said. The rapid response centre has been divided into two areas -- a

seven-bed triage area and a 23-bed ICU. All beds have multipara monitors with critical care equipment like ventilators, BIPAP machines, HFNC and crash carts, the official said. It is fully equipped with a centralised oxygen supply and suction is available for each bed. A rapid response team, comprising critical care consultants, resident doctors, nursing staff and orderlies, and technicians will man the centre.

Patients will be provided complete critical care at the centre till bed availability is ensured in a COVID-19 ward or a Covid ICU ward, the official said. "Under the guidance of CM Arvind Kejriwal, to combat the next Covid wave Delhi government has made a Rapid Response Centre at Rajiv Gandhi Super Speciality Hospital. This will be manned with a Rapid Response Team which will work 24/7 and will help in better management of Covid patients," Jain later tweeted. The Delhi health minister on Tuesday said medical infrastructure is being ramped up and 37,000 beds dedicated for COVID-19 patients are being set up to tackle the anticipated third wave of the pandemic in the national capital. He also underlined that though the positivity rate has shown a downward trend and the number of fatalities has been zero in the past few days, the Delhi government is not dropping its guard. (PTI)

Chidambaram arrives in Goa, to discuss strategy for 2022 polls

PANAJI, AUG 25 --/ Former Union minister and newly-appointed AICC election observer for Goa, P Chidambaram, today arrived in the coastal state for a two-day visit during which he is likely to discuss the party's strategy with local leaders for the Assembly polls, due in February next year.

A senior Congress leader didn't rule out the possibility of Chidambaram holding pre-poll alliance talks during his visit. This is Chidambaram's maiden visit to Goa after he was appointed the AICC election observer for the coastal state. Earlier in the day, Chidambaram was received at the Goa airport by state Congress chief Girish Chodankar, Leader of Opposition Digambar Kamat and other leaders. Chidambaram, however, refused to answer the questions of reporters. Later later I am here, he told media persons. Chidambaram also didn't reply when asked if Congress will retain Girish Chodankar as the Goa unit president or replace him with an eye on polls.

Meanwhile, Chodankar didn't rule out the holding of pre-poll alliance talks during Chidambaram's visit. "Everything related to upcoming elections would be discussed," he told PTI when asked about the possibility of Chidambaram holding pre-poll discussions. The Congress won the highest 17 seats in the 40-member House in the 2017 Goa Assembly elections, restricting the main opponent BJP to 13. But the saffron party moved swiftly to ally with regional parties and came to power under the leadership of senior leader Manohar Parrikar, now deceased. Over years, Congress's strength in the Legislative Assembly dwindled to five after many of its MLAs switched sides and joined the ruling BJP. Chodankar had resigned last year after Congress fared poorly in Zilla Panchayat elections in Goa, but the party is yet to accept his resignation. As per speculation, Chodankar is likely to be replaced with another senior leader in the run-up to the Assembly polls. A Goa Congress functionary had said Chidambaram will meet leaders and discuss a party strategy for the polls during his visit. Chidambaram will interact with PCC office-bearers, frontal bodies of Congress, district and block presidents and receive inputs. Goa Pradesh Congress Committee vice president (Organisation) M K Sheikh had said. He will visit the Congress House in Panaji on August 25 and travel to the South Goa District Office of the party for a meeting on August 26, according to Sheikh. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) has already thrown its hat in the ring ahead of the polls, with the party's national convener and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal announcing free power up to 300 units per month if his party is voted to power during his visit to Panaji in July. SC asks Delhi HC to decide in 2 weeks plea against appointment of Rakesh Asthana as Delhi Police chief

NEW DELHI, AUG 25 --/ The Supreme Court today asked Delhi High Court to decide within two weeks the plea pending before it challenging the appointment of senior IPS officer Rakesh Asthana as Delhi Police Commissioner.

The 1984-batch IPS officer was shifted to the Union cadre from Gujarat and appointed Commissioner on July 27 -- four days before his superannuation on July 31 -- for a tenure of one year. A bench comprising Chief Justice N V Ramana and Justices D Y Chandrachud and Surya Kant permitted NGO, Centre for Public Interest Litigation (CPIL), to move the Delhi High Court to intervene in the pending plea against Asthana's appointment. "We request the Delhi High Court to consider the matter as early as possible in two weeks for us to have the benefit of the high court's judgement. The petitioner (CPIL) is at liberty to file intervention application (before Delhi HC)", it said in the order.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, opposed the PIL saying the matter pertained to the appointment of police chief of a state and the high court concerned should deal with it. He said the high court may be granted some more time instead of two weeks as so far no notice has been issued to the Centre which will have to file its response.

The petition, moved by advocate Prashant Bhushan, urged the court to set aside the Centre's order to appoint Asthana after extending his service period. At the outset, the CJI expressed his inability to hear the PIL saying, I had expressed my views during the selection of CBI Director.

The CJI in an earlier meeting of the high-powered selection panel, which also comprised the Prime Minister and the leader of opposition, had put forth the legal position which reportedly led to non-consideration of Asthana for being appointed as the CBI Director. "There are two issues. One is about my participation... I had expressed views about the selection of this gentleman in the CBI Director selection. Second thing... as somebody has filed a petition in the High Court, rightly or wrongly. We understand that time is of the essence of the matter. So, we will fix a time limit of two weeks for the high court to decide the case and we will have the benefit of the high court judgment also, CJI Ramana said. Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the NGO, alleged foul play saying sometimes ambush petitions by simply resorting to cut-paste is filed in collusion with the government. The bench gave Bhushan the liberty to intervene in the pending petition or file a fresh one before the high court. Mehta said a similar

plea was pending in the high court and the NGO be asked to move there and asked which fundamental right of Bhushan has been violated leading him to file the petition in the apex court. Bhushan retorted that on his petition the appointment of Central Vigilance Commissioner was annulled in past, and Asthana's appointment has been done by "egregious violations of rules" resulting into violation of fundamental rights of citizens. The government has shown brazen violation of rule of law and gave extension of service by appointing Asthana few days before his retirement, he said.

The conditions have been laid down by the apex court in the Prakash Singh's case that recommendation has to come through the UPSC and the officer should have a minimum six months of service left at the time of appointment, Bhushan said. "So far as ambush petitions are concerned, less said is better. We have professional PIL litigants, who file surrogate pleas at behest of people who lost out in race," Mehta said towards the end of hearing. The appointment of Asthana to the post of Commissioner of Police, Delhi must be set aside on the same principle, it said. Besides, it said that endeavour should be made that a person appointed as DGP has reasonable period of service left. (PTI)

Over 60 crore Covid vaccine doses administered in India: Govt

NEW DELHI, AUG 25 --/ The cumulative number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country surpassed the 60-crore mark today, Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said. "Under PM @NarendraModi ji's #Sabko VaccineMft Vaccine initiative, India crossed the 60 crore vaccination mark. Congratulations everyone!" he said in a tweet. India took 85 days to touch the figure of 10 crore. It then took 45 days to touch the 20-crore mark and 29 more days to reach 30 crore, the minister informed. The country

took 24 days to reach 40 crore from 30 crore and then 20 more days to cross 50 crore vaccinations on August 6. It took 19 more days to go past the 60-crore mark, Mandaviya said. The countrywide vaccination drive was rolled out on January 16 with healthcare workers (HCWs) getting inoculated in the first phase. The vaccination of frontline workers (FLWs) started from

February 2. The next phase of COVID-19 vaccination commenced from March 1 for people over 60 years of age and those aged 45 and above with specified co-morbid conditions. The country launched vaccination for all people aged more than 45 years from April 1. The government then decided to expand its vaccination drive by allowing everyone above 18 to be vaccinated from May 1. (PTI)
